1. The highest bidder to be the purchaser, subject to the reservation that the Auctioneer shall have the right to (a) regulate the bidding, (b) reject any bid, (c) determine at his absolute discretion all disputes regarding the bidding or any other matters arising under these Conditions, and of bidding for, withdrawing, consolidating, dividing or altering the order of the lots. No person shall be allowed to retract his or her bidding.
2. The purchaser shall pay to the Auctioneers commission at the rate of 5% of the purchase price on each and every lot purchased.
3. All bids shall be exclusive of Value Added Tax and VAT will be charged on the hammer price on each lot, if applicable, unless the Auctioneer specifically states otherwise at the time of sale.
4. The purchase money together with the commission and V.A.T. shall become payable at the fall of the hammer, if required, and must be paid on the day of the sale, such payment being made to the Auctioneer or his Clerk only. Payment by cheque must be accompanied by satisfactory references.
