All electrical items are sold on the express condition that the winner ensures they are examined by a competent electrician before connecting them to any source of electricity.

### RESERVE PRICES

Some items have a reserve price. Where necessary, the Auctioneer will protect the reserve on an item and use his discretion up to 10%. If this price is not reached, the Auctioneer will record the item as unsold and move on to the next item.

### THE BUYER


