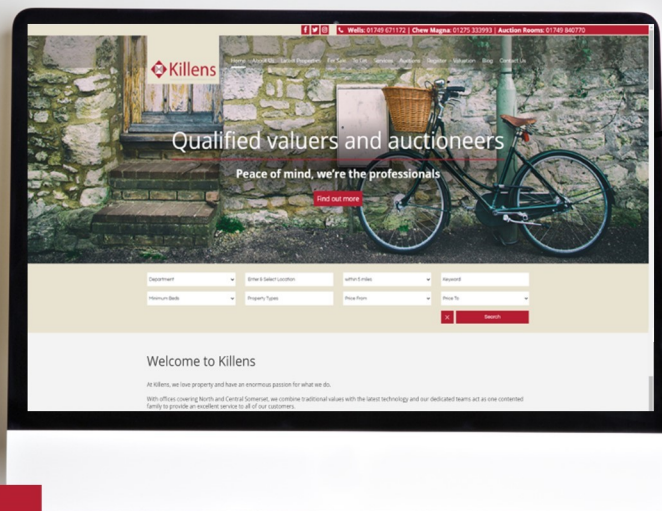

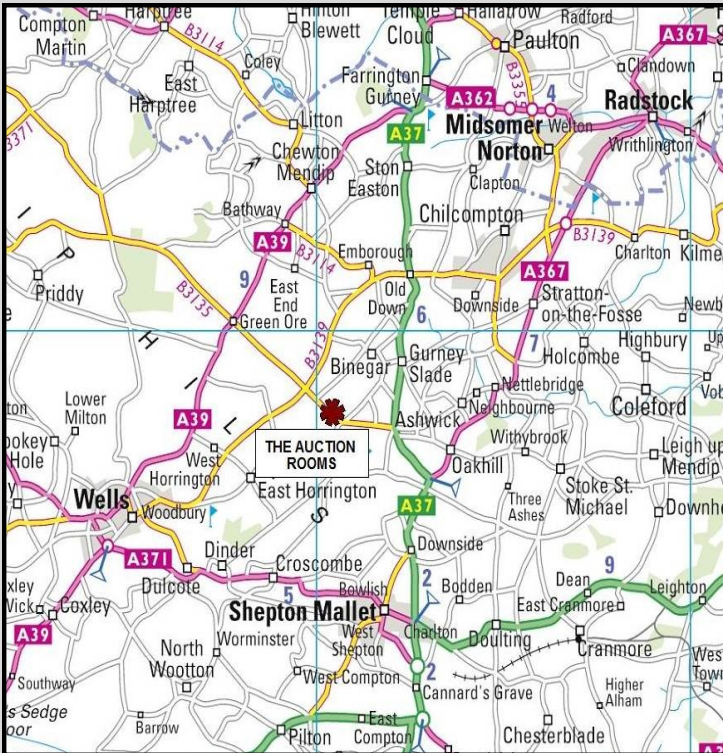

2 Bidding procedures and the Buyer
