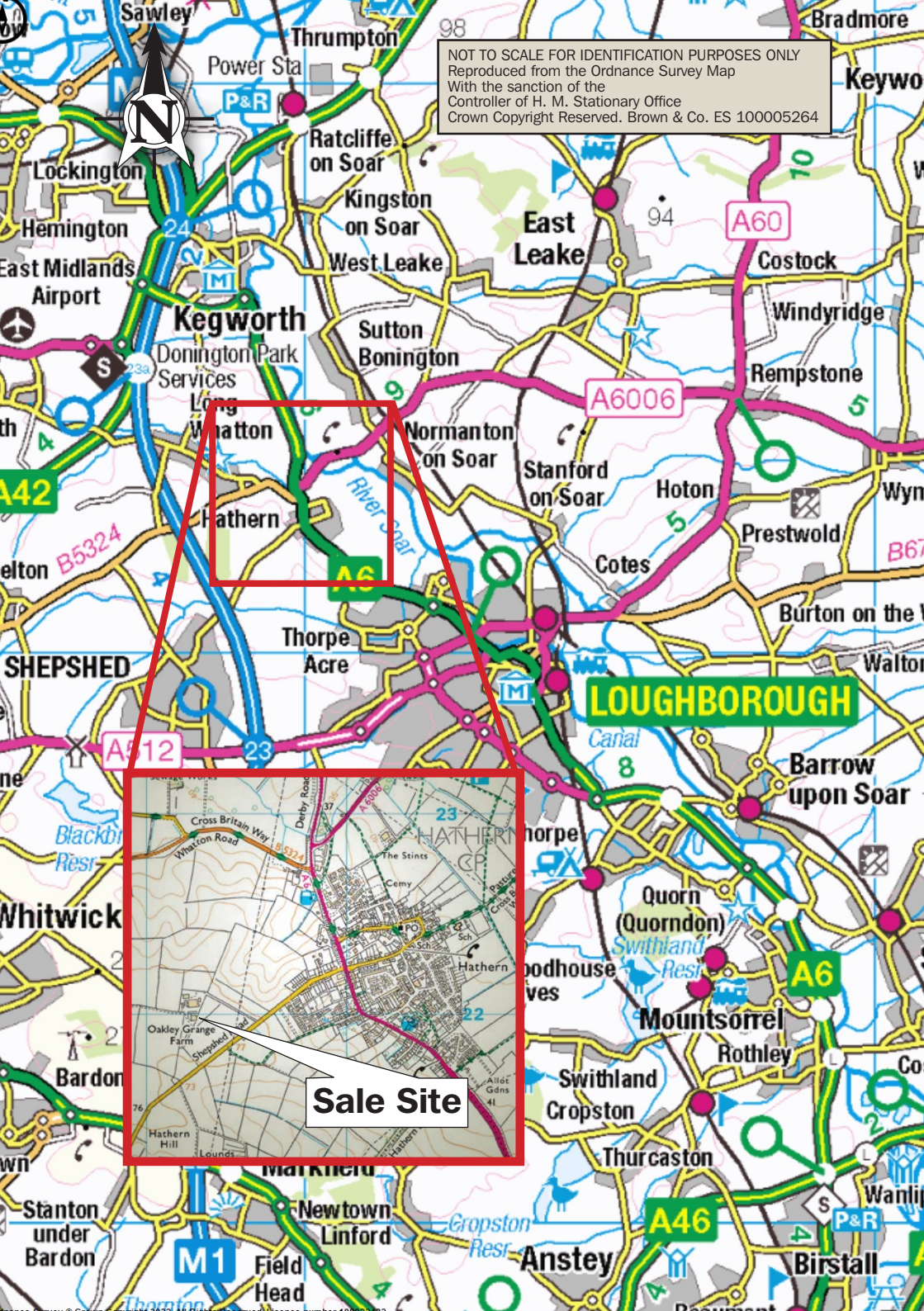

PURCHASERS PLEASE NOTE:

LOCATION – From the M1, exit at Junction 23 towards Loughborough and Shepshed. Take the exit for Shepshed and continue along the A512. After approximately 0.5 miles turn right onto Leicester Road. Follow Leicester Road for approximately 0.7 miles and at the mini roundabout take the first exit onto Kirkhill. At the next mini-roundabout take the second exit onto Field Street and at the next mini-roundabout turn right onto Brook Street. Follow Brook Street out of Shepshed where it leads onto Hathern Road. After going under the M1 Motorway the farm is located approximately 1 mile on the left-hand side.

From Loughborough head north on the A6 towards Hathern. In Hathern at the traffic lights turn left onto Shepshed Road. The Farm is located approximately 0.3 miles on the right-hand side.

The sale ground will be signposted on the sale day. **The nearest postcode for the sale ground is LE12 5LL.**

All persons attending the sale ground are reminded that there may be risks on the site including moving machinery and vehicles and to exercise caution at all times with any children being fully supervised at all times. Any incidents that occur on the sale ground should be reported immediately to the Brown & Co Fox Bennett office for details to be recorded. No vehicles will be permitted onto the sale ground during the sale.

COVID 19 GUIDELINES

Any modification to, or deletion of, a provision or part-provision under this clause shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the rest of the Conditions.

(ii) If any provision or part-provision of the Conditions is invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the parties shall negotiate in good faith to amend that provision so that, as amended, it is legal, valid and enforceable, and, to the greatest extent possible, achieves the intended commercial result of the original provision.

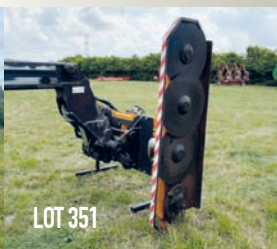
