KATSUTARO INABATA, president of the Osaka Chamber of Commerce, as well as of the Muslin Spinning Co., and a director of several other large industries. AKIRA ISHII, connected with the Nippon Yusen Kaisha, and was manager of the company's London branch for some years in England. TAKASHI ISAKA, president of the Yokohama Fire and Marine Insurance Co., as well as of the Yokohama Chamber of Commerce. MASASUKE ITANI, managing director of the Yamashita Steamship Co., and a well-known ship magnate in Japan. MORIMATSU ITANI, head of the well-known dry goods house, m Nagoya, and also a director of the Ito Savings Bank. CHOKURO KADONO, vice president of Okura and Co., and director of the East Asia Industrial Co., is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, New York, and member of the Iron and Steel Institute of London. MANZO KUSHIDA, president of the Mitsubishi Bank, and a director of most of the corporations with which this company is concerned. Dr. KOJIRO MAGOSHI, director of the Electro Chemical Industry Co., and an expert chemist. KENJIRO MATSUMOTO, an expert in mining, and president of the Meiji Mining Company. He is also chairman of the Wakamatsu Harbour Construction Co., and other large concerns. SEIJIRO MIYAJIMA, president of the Nisshin Cotton Spinning Co. Dr. TATSUMI MOCHIDA, chief engineer of the Fuji Gas Spinning Co. BARON KUMAKICHI NAKASHIMA, connected with the Tokyo Stock Exchange and the Seoul Fusan Railway Co., president of the Furukawa Electrical Industry Co., which comprises the Yokohama Electric Cable Co. Is a member of the House of Peers. KANA O NANJO, managing director of the Mitsubishi Kaisha, otherwise known as Messrs. Mitsui and Co. SHINTARO OHASHI, one of the founders of the largest publishing concern in Japan, and is connected with over 60 corporations, of most of which he is a director. TOKUTARO SAKAI, acting secretary of the Mission, a member of Messrs. Mitsui and Co. Was formerly private secretary to the Minister of Foreign Affairs, and in 1912 to the Prime Minister. GISAKU TAKIKAWA, president of the Oriental Match Co., and a director of several large corporations. NORIHIKO YATSUSHIRO, manager of the Sumitomo Bank in Osaka. UMEKICHI YONEYAMA, connected with the Mitsui Bank, of which he is one of the managing directors. The Mission arrived in this country from the United States on December 19th, and during their visit were received by Cabinet Ministers, prominent Labour Leaders, Local Government bodies, leading bankers, and shipowners. The Mission attended formal meetings of the principal commercial organisations and had many social engagements. They also fully investigated our police methods, the regulation of traffic, signalling, the general operation of steam and electric railways, commercial enterprises, methods of road construction, as well as the London sewage system, etc. It will thus be seen, as already stated, that their visit was a business one in the fullest sense of the word, and

their itinerary was of a very comprehensive nature. After a fortnight in London, the Mission visited Manchester, Birmingham, Liverpool, Sheffield, Glasgow and Newcastle during a provincial tour, which extended over a period of two weeks. Upon being apprised of the visit of this Mission by the Overseas Department of the Board of Trade, every endeavour was made to arrange for the members to visit Bedford to inspect the Queen's Engineering Works, but their time being so fully mapped out, it was found impossible for this visit to be effected. Dr. Takuma Dan, however, the leader of the Mission, expressed a keen desire to meet Mr. R. W. Allen who he remembered having met in Japan, and on January 26th, an informal conference took place at the Victoria Hotel, London, between Dr. Dan, Mr. Nanjo, Mr. Hatanaka and Mr. Richard Allen, at which affairs in general and engineering matters in particular were discussed, the party afterwards being entertained to lunch. Dr. Dan was extremely interested in all we had to tell him in regard to our activities in Bedford and expressed regret that time did not permit of their coming here to see the work which we have in hand. He was particularly pleased to learn of the various contracts which we at present are completing for Japan, and stated he was well aware of our capabilities, being acquainted with much of the machinery which we have installed in various parts of his country. It was very gratifying to hear from Dr. Dan that the object of the Mission to this country had been accomplished, and that they had greatly benefited by all they had seen. They were particularly impressed with the energy exhibited by private enterprise. Dr. Dan said that he could not find words to sufficiently express the admiration he felt for the wonderful pluck, not only of these private enterprises, but also of the private individual, and stated he was convinced it was this quality that had made the English so successful in building the British Empire. Dr. Dan added that apart from the material advantages the Mission derived from their visit they had gained moral advantages, which he said they owed to the personal contact they had experienced. This will no doubt bear a large part in leading to a more thorough knowledge and better understanding between the two countries and serve as a basis for mutual confidence in the future, upon which not only will trade and industrial relations repose more solidly, but national confidence in each other's merits be secured.
