

The hammered vase with the mark of William Comyns, London 1902, 18.5cm high (7 1/4 inches), loaded base; the pair of inverted pear-shaped and floral embossed cruets with hallmarks for Birmingham 1905, the two weigh 62g, in a fitted case; the clear cut-glass jar with a silver cover, mark of H Mathews, Birmingham 1930, the lid 41g £30 50
- **2** A vintage silver mounted easel-back rectangular photograph frame with a heart-shaped aperture. Within a broad border embossed with flowers and a vacant cartouche, hallmarks for London 1993, approx. 20cm high overall, 10.5cm wide (8 x 4 1/4 inches) £30 40
