This seaman's diary and an interesting group of printed ephemera relate to the progress of Darro* (w.e.f 11 January 1921 HMS Dartmouth; and w.e.f 15.4.21 HMS Southampton) as part of the South Atlantic Squadron shortly after WWI.
The diary is handmade with fabric covers stitched on. It is written in ink, longhand and is intact. It opens with an epic verse written by Warrant Shipwright A C Morris RN to mark the setting sail at Christmas, 1920 of the crew of HMS Dartmouth aboard SS Darro. This is an original piece.
The tour diary continues to April 1923 having taken in South America, Falkland Islands, South Africa, India, Sri Lanka and the Seychelles. The diary is a comprehensive account of routines, locations and impressions, including record of personal feelings. The ships visit by the then Prince of Wales, later King Edward VIII is nicely recorded.
*Darro was a steamship built in 1912 and which was in a tragic episode in 1917 when it caused a collision in fog, occasioning the deaths of 600 crew of SS Mandi.
