All items are sold without any warranty or claim as to its suitability or fitness for its apparent purpose so as a prospective Buyer, you should use your judgement. The wording A/F within the description is an indication that the lot may not be in good condition. All electrical items are sold on the express condition that the winner ensures they are examined by a competent electrician before connecting them to any source of electricity.

Condition Reports will be supplied until 4 p.m. the day before auction day.

All sales are final and no refunds are given.

RESERVE PRICES

Some items have a reserve price. Where necessary, the Auctioneer will protect the reserve on an item and use his discretion up to 10%. If this price is not reached, the Auctioneer will record the item as unsold and move on to the next item.

THE BUYER
